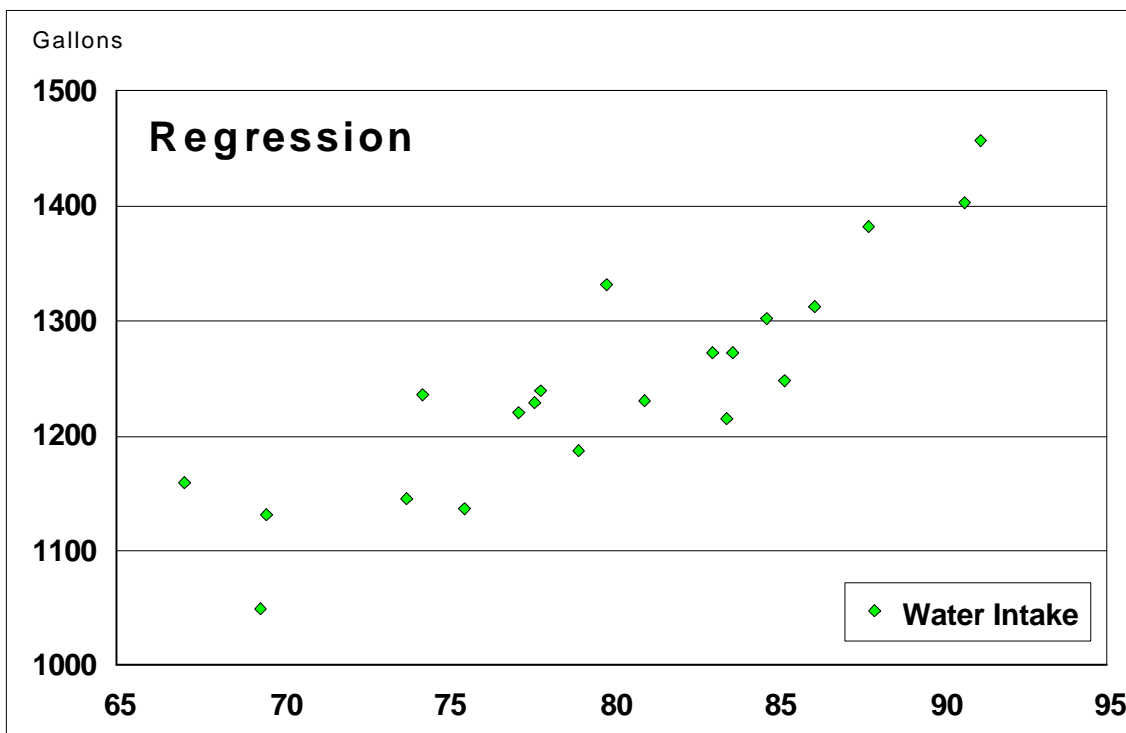
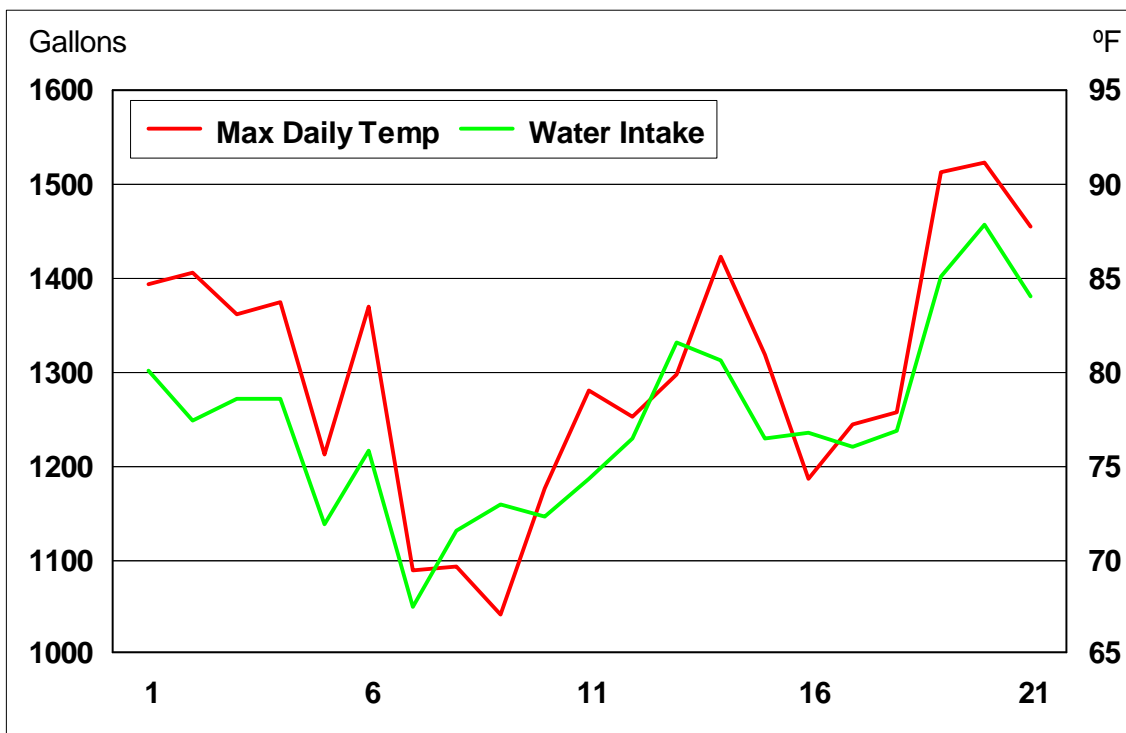


Effect of high temperatures on water intake



Finishing building holding 950 animals, figures over a 21 day period.

In this case there appears to be a clear relationship between high peak daily temperatures and water use - around 1.45% increase in consumption per °F above 70°F

This may or may not be typical for the size of pig, and there could be a possibility that pigs are using the water to wet their skin, rather than drinking it.
